IMPORTANT PRE-OPERATIVE CONSIDERATIONS

We use only the safest anesthetics available. All pets are given an examination prior to anesthesia is done at no charge. Certain recommendations may have been made prior to today in the best interest of your pet.

Pre-operative Blood Tests

The doctors highly recommend a series of blood tests to better evaluate your pet's health status. These test become more important as an animal ages or has other health conditions. These tests help rule out pre-existing conditions that might not be evident on physical examination or guide additional therapy. Results are evaluated prior to proceeding with anesthesia. The cost of this service is \$50.00. These tests are optional but highly advised. Please initial your preference below.

Intra-operative Fluid Therapy

Intravenous catheters and fluids are used to maintain blood pressure and hydration, which can be crucial to recovery. This becomes even more important as an animal ages, if it has certain pre-existing conditions or if anesthesia and procedures are lengthy. The cost for this care is \$35.00. Pain Management

If a painful procedure is to be done, medication will be dispensed after surgery to help manage pain at home. A pain injection can also be given prior to this procedure to aid in recovery and pain management before your pet has a chance to feel it. The cost of this injection is \$24.00 to \$27.00.
